Dear Participants!

Now we have received the final application information.

For the application via the German Kyudo Federation you will need:

- The examination application form (with the right examination date, see below). (If you don't trust postal services to be in time, you can send copies of the form per pdf, as backup)
- The application form of the German Kyudo Federation
- Copy of money transfer to our banking account (application and handling fees)
- Medical certificate, not older than 6 months at the date of the examination, if you are going to shoot in standing form.
- The filled out application excel form (only this form should be send back by e-mail)

All this forms should arrive at the Federations office **before April the 28th 2011**.

The fees are calculated in respect to eventual exchange rate shifts.

The German Kyudo Federation has decided, in the case that there is a surplus, to donate this sum to the Japan disaster aid (e.g. Red Cross).

If you don't accept this, please state so on the German kyudo Federation application form.

If you have passed the examination successfully you will have to pay a diploma fee. We don't have the information yet, but very likely it has to be transferred to Japan after the event by each Federation. We will inform you in time about this.

The diploma fees (except for Renshi) are round about 1000 Yen more than the application fee per Dan.)
